

FAQ's

We know that you probably have many questions, so we have compiled the most frequently asked ones.

What is a giving campaign?

A giving campaign in a church context is an intentional effort designed to challenge people in their growth, understanding and action around biblical generosity. This campaign is designed to raise money within a defined time to increase the capacity of the church to carry out its mission.

What is included in this giving campaign?

This giving campaign will raise money for:

- Our new church building
- New ministries
- Additional staffing
- Equipment
- Many other needs that come with a new building

Why are we changing our name?

Our new name, Real Life Selkirk, represents our broader geographic region. The move to our Oldtown property means that it no longer makes sense to carry "Newport" in our church name. Our region is located in the Selkirk mountains, so changing our name to Real Life Selkirk communicates that our church is for the whole community, not just one city.

What is the goal the Building a Legacy campaign?

The goal of our Building a Legacy campaign is 100% engagement. We want to step into this God-sized project unified. It is our hope that every person who considers Real Life Selkirk their home would contribute to the Building a Legacy campaign. We have chosen not to set a financial goal for the campaign and to trust God in what the church will give.

Who makes the decisions? Who has the oversight?

The Real Life Selkirk elders have oversight of the giving campaign. For the duration of the campaign, the elders will be responsible for the use and management of all funds given.

Who sees what I commit to give?

Only the Real Life Selkirk financial team will see who has submitted commitment cards and for what amount. This tracking is necessary as part of responsibility to the elders and to the generous givers within the church.

Does this campaign replace my tithe or my general giving?

No, this campaign does not replace your tithe or your general giving. All of our normal offering that is typically given is included in our General Fund to be used to maintain and expand our existing ministries. Campaign funds are given above and beyond the regular giving, and will be used exclusively on the building project.

Will we have to finance any part of this project?

We would certainly like to minimize potential debt in this building project. This is why we have a giving campaign. However, in the event that the costs of the project extend beyond our committed funds, we have partnered with a church extension fund called The Solomon Foundation. TSF exclusively works with churches by offering financing, guidance and relationship. For more information, please visit: www.thesolomonfoundation.org

Are there alternative ways to give?

Of course! There are numerous options to give that are often overlooked:

- If you own your own company, you can give from your company
- Company matching programs
- Personal income gifts
- Appreciated stock
- Real estate IRA-qualified charitable distribution

Are gifts to the giving campaign tax deductible?

Yes! Real Life Selkirk is a 501 (c) (3) non-profit organization. EIN 27-4018417

Can I give anonymously?

Yes, as a giver you can always give anonymously. However, your gift will not be recorded under your giving profile, therefore you will not receive a year end tax receipt for your anonymous gift. We will make sure that your gift is recorded with the giving campaign. Rest assured that the same level of confidentiality that is held with our regular giving will be shared with campaign giving.

How long is my commitment?

We are asking that everyone make a two-year commitment. The fulfillment period for your commitment will begin in November 2024 and finish in October 2026.

What if I have never given before?

As a part of our growth as disciples, one area of maturity God calls us to is generosity. As you step out in faith by giving, we ask that you would first give to the general fund of the church before deciding to give to the Building a Legacy campaign. Building a Legacy asks for funds that are given above and beyond regular giving so our current ministries can sustain and grow. As you grow as a disciple, we ask you begin giving in this way and if God directs give above that amount to the Building a Legacy fund. We welcome you to the team!

What if I am new to Real Life Selkirk?

Building a Legacy is about the vision for our church and our personal discipleship in giving as followers of Jesus. We believe that the local church is one of the most compelling mission to give towards, and we would love for you to make Real Life Selkirk your home. We encourage you to relationally connect to the church through one of our small groups and begin growing as a disciple of Jesus. This is the perfect time for you to put a stake in the ground and make this your church. We need you on the team!

How do I give?

Ways to give:

- **Sunday Worship Service-** You can give cash or check in the designated boxes during our Sunday morning worship services.
- **Online** Giving is available online at www.reallifeselkirk.com. Online giving offers the option of recurring giving to simplify the process.
- **In Person-** In the event you have a special gift or did not give during the Sunday morning worship service, you can bring your giving to the church office. If needed, arrangements can be made by contacting the office at 509-447-2164.

What are my next steps?

- **Pray-** Seek God's leading in what He is asking of you. Prepare your heart to hear Him and obey what He directs. Also, spend time in prayer for the leadership of the church and those involved in this building project.
- **Grow-** Connect in a small group this season, if you haven't already. Find a place to minister or serve within the church. Our church needs every part of the body to fulfill our mission.
- **Commit** Prayerfully consider what sacrificial commitment God is directing you to give. Our goal is for 100% participation within our church body. Even a small gift given faithfully can make a big difference. Fill out your commitment card and submit it in the designated areas at church. If you are unable to fill out a commitment card, contact the church office to make arrangements for your gift.
- **Celebrate** As we see God doing His work within Real Life Selkirk, we must take time to worship and celebrate. We serve a good God who never ceases to amaze. We are excited to see Him move in huge ways as the church pulls together in obedience to Him.
